From Your Priest:



" The Charcoal Fire" John 21:1-19

An awful lot can happen with Jesus Christ in a short period of time. We have recently heard how the disciples—especially Peter demonstrated their raw humanity in the hour of their Lord's trial and execution. No more poignant illustration of fear can be found than that on display in John 18:18, with Peter

shivering in the courtyard as Christ is being interrogated. It is a chilly night, and the servants make a charcoal fire. Peter, too, stands over the fire and warms himself, as he denies three times that he knows Jesus. His accent gives him away to the servant girl, but he continues his emphatic three-time denial anyway. Now, a few days later, everything has changed. The Risen Lord has revealed himself to the disciples. On the shore, Jesus makes a charcoal fire for them to cook breakfast. There, over the charcoal fire, Christ asks Peter-three times-if he loves him. We're told that Peter gets his feelings hurt, as if in the face of Peter's denials, Jesus should just let the matter go. What a difference in Peter's life and in our lives has God accomplished in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Fear has been overcome with love. We are no longer struggling just to keep warm to skate by. Our very hearts are warmed by God's light. Peter's life was never the same after the second charcoal fire. Our lives are not the same, either.
