" Advocacy 101"
John 14:8-17, 25-27

Jesus tells us that he will ask the Father to give us another Advocate, the Holy Spirit sent by God the Father in the name of Jesus. To teach us everything. To remind us of all that Christ has said to us. This promise, the animating force of the Church,

is an amazing gift. What is an *advocate*, anyway? Chiefly the role is one of support and of pleading on behalf of us. The Trinity—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit has been revealed to us in a very personal way. In like manner, God remains directly involved in the human condition, most remarkably through the Church.

Every Pentecost, we are reminded of the very birth of the Church. It's a Big Bang moment to be sure. It calls for fireworks and celebration. Does it mean that we have an easy path as people of faith? Or that we won't mess up from time to time? No, but we have the blessings of the Advocate that transcends time and space. This gift has transformed those who have come before at St. Mary's and it will continue to do so for all time.
