From Your Priest:



"Surprise, Surprise!" Luke 12:32-40

The Jesus we find in Luke is one who prepares us for surprises. In last week's lesson, the guy who was rich (He had lots of stuff) but also a "fool" (He didn't get that it would not buy him another day) was

taken completely by surprise. This week, Jesus continues with the theme. We have to be prepared, like the master who is up and ready when the thief comes; he or she is not asleep or distracted. We are to be dressed and ready to serve, not taken by surprise and unsettled by the knock on the door. The Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour. How much of our life is spent making plans that do not have anything to do with God? How much time to we invest in preparing for that unexpected hour that Jesus speaks of? The gifts that God provides to those who prepared are abundant and wonderfully surprising.


THINK ON THIS:
