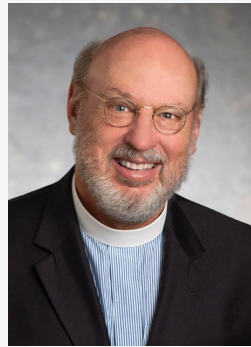

"Lost and Found" **Luke 15:1-10**

Ever had that sinking feeling when you can't find something? Where could you have left your (prescription) sunglasses that you need to drive. . .you retrace your steps, asking if anyone has seen them? (That happened to me in Lampasas this week.) Did you ever have a dog you love run off? (Me, again last week—he came back after hours of searching and worry). Of course, it can get even more painful when you lose a relationship by any number of means. Loss equals pain, dislocation, and sometimes shock. 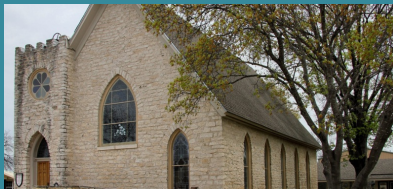
