

"Forty Days Since Christmas" Luke 2:22-40

The mystery of the Incarnation, the Word Made Flesh is highlighted in the lovely testimony of Simeon and Anna. We have

the power of the Song of Simeon in our Prayer Book (BCP 120). In his old age, Simeon proclaims liberation—his soul is set free—at the sight of the Savior, Jesus Christ. Anna, elderly and devoted to God can see what most cannot. She is alert to the unexpected gifts and surprises that God brings into human life in Christ. We have models of faith and vision in this little episode in Luke, which comes this Sunday, 40 days after Christmas. Their lyrical testimony should not be overlooked. They were deeply blessed by God, but they were also eager to share their blessing with us. It's a Christmas carol in February.
