"Salt & light, Anyone?"

Matthew 5:13-20

We often think of our faith in terms of finding ways to be closer to God. We seek to pierce the veil of the mortal and peer into the eternal. Jesus uses practical images to expand our thinking in that

regard, calling us to understand how God works. God came into the world in Jesus Christ, and is ever present in the things of this mortal life. Jesus reminds us that when we care for and love others—when we see Christ in every human being—we are the salt of the earth. We ourselves can be God's light in the world, just as Christ is, and accomplish God's intents and purposes. In our prayer at the opening of the Eucharist, we ask to "magnify God's holy Name." That's where our salt and light come in, and that is how Christ tells us to be closer to God.
