"First Be Reconciled" Matthew 5:21-37

Jesus offers us some good advice on moral grounds. (It's good legal advice, too, but I digress. . .) He says that if we are on our way to court, it is a good idea to come to terms and to reconcile before

we face the judge. The import of that image should not be lost on us in our high-tech age. In our created, human condition we will face a real Creator-God. It will not be anonymous, the way social media is or the other forums where we can spend our days in ego-driven spats. Jesus tells us there will be a settlement day at the courthouse. It is time to reconcile while the price is reasonable. Jesus is asking us to consider the cost in our relationship with God as we demean and insult the very creatures God himself has created.
