"The Kingdoms of This World" Matthew 4:1-11

Jesus is taken up a very high mountain to get a good view. There, he is offered all the kingdoms of the world—in all their

"splendor", to be exact. That must have been quite a sight! And a remarkable temptation, too. The temptation is thinking that a future could be secured with worldly goods, and structures that support them--maybe even just a part of it. Jesus, fully human, sees more clearly than we do. He knows our need for daily bread; he calls us to care for the poor. But he also knows the temptation to serve two masters. Lent is a good time to examine our temptation to serve the material, especially as we are reminded that we are "but dust, and to dust we shall return."
