Exodus 17:1-7

From Your Priest:



"Is the Lord Among Us or Not" Exodus 17:1-7

Moses had his hands full, to say the least. Guided by the Lord, Moses leads the people of Israel out of slavery, up

from the yoke of Pharaoh. It did not take long for trouble to develop. Panic set in. Quarreling began. There were murmurings. It was so easy for the people of God to forget God's providence and mercy. It's the sort of "What have you done for me lately?" mentality. Moses turned to God, telling him that he (Moses) was about to get stoned! We hear a very human response to uncertainty in the Book of Exodus. It plays out across human history. When there is doubt, disease, discouragement and dread, we are prone to forget the God who liberates us from slavery. As we face the diseases and doubts of our day, let us keep God's providence central to our thinking.
