


# St. Mary's MESSENGER



side. Offering them "Peace," he gives them a great mission

—Christ sends them (and us) into the world just as he has been sent into the world. A new commission in the name of Jesus Christ is created. We call it the Church. Pentecost is the birthday of the Church.

In triumph over suffering and death, Christ breathes on them and gives his Church the Holy Spirit, another revelation of the household of God. He tells them to "receive" the Spirit, as a gift which is presented, and is to be greeted with great joy as it guides, sustains, and comforts the Church. How's that for a birthday present?

"Don't worry about me not knowing life and treating it foolishly. I want to go back to America so bad its not even funny. I want to enjoy all the good things we are so lucky to have. I wont get any medals here in Special Forces for what I have done or will do, but inside I'll always know what I am capable of doing and what I have done with pride. I had men die for me in 1776, 1812, the Alamo, the Civil War, the Spanish-American War, World War I & II and in Korea. I feel like I owe someone something by being here. I love life, and I love fighting for my country. It's a son of a gun and scares me to death sometimes, but it's what I like, fighting for our flag and country. Sounds crazy, but I realize more and more how wonderful life is in America."
